To access the Class web page on the Juniata web site go to the Juniata web site at <http://www.juniata.edu/>, then SELECT Alumni & Donors, then SELECT Campus Connections, then SELECT Class Websites, then SELECT Class of 1964, then enter Username - Alumni and Password - WelcomeBack (remember to use a capital "A", "W" and "B" and to make WelcomeBack all one word). Million Dollar Endowment - The following is an extract from the Harrisburg Patriot-News that I thought might interest you. "With \$6 in his pocket, lugging the tattered suitcase his father had used when he emigrated from Ireland, Chuck Knox sneaked off to Juniata College in the summer of 1950. The stealth was required because his stern father disapproved, preferring that young Chuck make his living in the blast furnaces and open hearths like just about everybody else in the western Pennsylvania town of Sewickley. But Juniata offered Knox a chance to walk on to the football team. It offered an opportunity, and it offered an escape. And Knox capitalized. More than half a century later, Knox repaid Juniata College with the endowment of \$1 million to fund a chair in the history department. The former Los Angeles Rams, Seattle Seahawks and Buffalo Bills coach, now living in La Quinta, California, said he wants to "give something back for the great experience I had there."
