Many members of the class of '64 received assistance as a scholarship or grant from this fund. We are inviting you to serve on a **Class Team** to lead your class in encouraging annual renewals to this fund. Working as a team will allow you to divide the responsibilities and work together to preserve your class identity and legacy to Juniata and help us change the lives of today's young people. Other successful teams like '73 (8 members), '84 (3 members), and 2005 (10 members), have a great time working together and find that the workload is very manageable.

Class Team responsibilities are:

- Crafting an appeal letter, printed by the college, with all paper, postage provided
- Early spring semester email to thank those who have given and to encourage a gift from those who have not yet made theirs
- Spring phone call campaign to give a personal touch to anyone from the class who has not yet made their gift
- Occasionally touching base with classmates in additional ways...sending holiday cards (provided by Juniata), passing along information, or requesting input from classmates

These responsibilities can be divided among team members any way that you choose, and our office is ready with any help you might need. For instance, you might craft the letter together and then divide up your classmates according to who you know (or knew!) and make contact with your list. Or, you might want to take part in just the phone calling, or whatever. We have room for everyone! We will provide you with all contact information, and Class Team members are provided access to a password protected site to view their class participation information, contacts, etc., so that you may work at your own pace rather than wait for information to come out from us.

Please consider coming on board and helping your class out with this project. Let's put a team together for 1964!
