Promised Founders-Brumbaugh-Oneida Memories – Well, none of you recalled any memories of time spent in and around the Founders-Brumbaugh-Oneida complex. So here are some of my memories that may trigger your own memories.

Remember a sure sign of the end of the spring term approaching was the sunbathers on the roof of the addition to Oneida – of course only females since you have to access the roof from a hall way in the Oneida Women's ONLY dorm. Every once in a while you would see a bathing suit clad miss pop up above the top of the wall.

Our senior year I returned to campus early – the excuse was to set up the Alfrata office in the cellar of Brumbaugh Hall. In addition it gave me a head start on setting up my dorm room too and a chance to check out the freshman class as they arrived a couple days before the rest of the students. Also in that area of Brumbaugh was WJC – I remember David Lee was one of the DJs.

Also thinking back all the way to our freshman year, remember the assigned seats in Oneida Dining Hall – two seniors, two junior, two sophomores and two freshman at most of the classes. Many of our classmate worked in the dining hall as servers – serving the family style meals. I was at a table with a Senior that was going with Tony Faber at the time – in fact I think the end up getting married after he graduated in 1962. They were having a lover's spat at the time and I was tasked by her to run notes to him at his off-campus housing.

And I am sure many of you spent some time in the offices in Founders Hall second and third floor. I remember Dr. Cherry had his office there at least on year. Most of those offices were in the part of Founders being torn down and reconstructed as part of the Founders renovation plan. Other offices in the building were the Registrar, Dean of Women – remember Dean Yohe and Dean of Men – Dean Heberling.

Ah yes, and the panty raids! Our freshman year we conducted a panty raid on Oneida. We were on the side of the building where the unused entrance to the dining room was located. 2007-2008 Scholarship Fund Drive Update – The “Double-Barrel” Approach –Both our class fund agents have sent me comments on the status of the funds. It is great to see both are so dedicated to this project – thanks Rich and Bill.

Rich Morgan provide this 2007-2008 Scholarship Fund Drive update. “As of 29 February, 2008, our class has reached the level of 42% donations to the Juniata Scholarship Fund which puts us 7% above last year at this time. Thus far we have had 63 donors out of a potential of 151; we need 28 more to reach the 60% goal that has been set for ourselves. In reviewing the list, some who have donated in the past have not thus far. Bill and myself will contact these classmates personally. I am confident that we will reach our goal in spite of having two neophytes as CFA's.”

Bill Chew added these thoughts that include comment about reaching the 50% goal to stay on Founders Steps. This is important because we want to be sure our Class is there when the building is rededicated in 2009 after renovation! Bill said: “We need 13 more contributors to reach 50%, 20 more to reach last year’s level of 56% and 28 more to reach the College goal of 60%. (I’m) shooting for following up to your March newsletter. I know we have some donors out there that just need a reminder.”

Fear not, you will not really be hit with a “Double-Barrel” request to contribute. Bill and Rich are sharing the responsibilities and each contacts a different group of classmates.
