As you may recall, last spring we discussed the possibility of selling Patrick Lodge. In October of this year I put together a team of faculty, students and staff to look at Patrick and develop a plan to make the property self-sustaining financially. It is my pleasure to announce the team has completed its work and has developed a plan we are confident will allow us to continue to have Patrick as a college owned and operated property! We were also fortunate to have the support of an anonymous donor which will allow us to complete some necessary repairs and upgrades to make the property more beautiful and functional. Rob Yelnosky will be putting out an announcement shortly outlining the details of the plan and asking for your support to help with implementation. Please see him if you have any interest in this important project."

**Historian to Receive Honorary Degree from Juniata** - Betty Ann Cherry, a resident of Huntingdon, Pa. and professor emerita of history at Juniata College, will receive an honorary doctorate of humane letters degree from Juniata College May 14 at 2 p.m. during Juniata's 127th commencement ceremony. (Betty Ann was a speaker at the Class of 1964 Reunion last year.)

Juniata will send back to you a receipt noting that your gift has been received and that it was deposited to the Class of 1964 – 50<sup>th</sup> Reunion Gift Fund. And, under the new procedure, these contributions are tax deductible in the year they are made.

Terry also provided the following update on the 50th Reunion Fund for March 2005 - An additional contribution was received from Jeanne Mather Stamm, Elaine Ake Frazier in the month of April 2005. As of May 4, 2005, 12 classmates have contributed. The account total, which will be transferred to OUR account at Juniata, is \$6,353.78 including interest.
